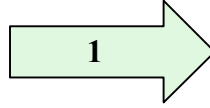


# Rotary District 6630 Grants Development Model

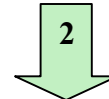
## Six Easy Steps to a District 6630 Grant



### Step One:

**You** present your idea to your Rotary Club. If agreed, then the Grants Inquiry Form is filled out. This form can be located at:

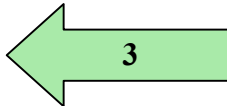

### Step Two:

Mail the completed form to:

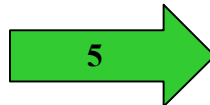
### Step Three:

A **grants coordinator** from the District Grants Committee is assigned to contact you and your club to go through the entire grants process, documentation, forms, guidelines, and signatures.



### Step Four:

The completed grant application is reviewed with **you**, your Rotary Club's assigned **foundation liaison**, and the **grants coordinator** who submits it to District 6630's Grant Committee's agenda.



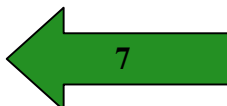
### Step Five:

**You** and the **grants coordinator** present the grant to District 6630's Grants Committee at their meeting: 7 pm - the first Monday of each month at: Maple Heights Library 5225 Library Lane Maple Heights, Ohio 44137



### Step Six:

District 6630 Grants Committee reviews and votes on your grant by their next meeting informing your club by mail. If your grant was an international grant, it will be forwarded to RI if approved.



### Step Seven if an international Grant:

The Rotary International Grant Committee will review the grant and vote notifying District 6630 by mail of the results.
